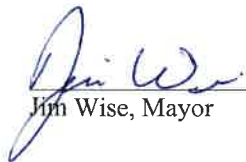

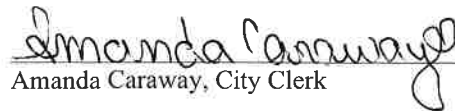
Reminder that January 17th at 5:30 p.m. is the Budget Workshop for City Council at City Hall.
